What will I get out of this?

Therapeutic story groups help school staff deal with challenging behaviour in the classroom – the noisy child who interrupts and seems unwilling to take anything in, the silent, withdrawn child who lets nothing out, the child who is always in a daydream or the child who seems unable to make sense of anything. They can help

- engage the hard-to-reach child in learning
- manage our experiences of a child who seems defended against thinking, learning and relating to others
- manage our "gut responses" to challenging behaviour in ways helpful to the child and ourselves.

What are therapeutic story groups?

Therapeutic story groups are recognised by the DCSF as an effective tool for helping school staff deal with challenging behaviour in the classroom and can be a key means of addressing children's social, emotional and behavioural difficulties.

This event will offer a practical introduction into how therapeutic story groups can help school staff in their work with challenging behaviour in the classroom.
