M.A. EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOTHERAPY

Educational psychotherapy is a highly effective way of supporting children and young people with emotional barriers to learning and to their social development. Therapeutic teaching methods, incorporated into everyday teaching, can help support children to overcome emotional barriers to learning. Individual or group work can offer consistency while the child develops a greater capacity to think and to learn.

We offer a stimulating four-year part-time MA in Educational Psychotherapy validated by Middlesex University. We draw on variety of models from attachment theory, child development, psychoanalytical theories, neuro-science and look at the use of play, creative expression and stories.

- When:** Part time over four academic years
10 sessions each term from 6.15 – 9.00 on Thursday evenings
- Who:** This course is suitable for anyone in Children's Services working directly with children as a teacher or in a supporting role
- What:** Each session comprises two parts, a seminar covering either work discussion or an observation course, with a break, followed by a lecture. The clinical training is in a CAMHS setting and includes supervision. This leads to registration with the United Kingdom Council for Psychotherapy as a qualified psychotherapist.
- Where:** At the Caspari Foundation, nearest underground stations Old Street or Angel
