Time involved

Course Outline

The basis of the work is in psychoanalytic theory and attachment and the application of these ideas in an educational context. Modules explore: theoretical concepts in educational psychotherapy; attachment theory and the practice of therapeutic teaching; work discussion – where theory and practice meet.
